

Eligibility

- a. Open only to IIA Members of Tamilnadu Chapter.
- b. Those who are not members of IIA can apply for new membership and participate by attaching the copy of acknowledgement from IIA.
- c. Participants must fall within the age group categories (25-32 or 33-40) as on the submission date.
- d. Proof of age (aadhaar card copy) to be attached with registration.
- e. All submissions must reflect works designed or executed by the participant's practice, either individually or as a team lead.
- f. All the submitted sheets will become the property of IIA-TN chapter.

Project Scope

- a. Entries must be built projects located within or outside Tamilnadu
- b. Projects should have been completed between 2018 and 2024.

Registration Fee

- a. The registration charges for awards will be **Rs.5000/-** per entry per category.
- b. Any additional entries by the same participant in other categories will be charged on the basis of **Rs. 2500/-** per entry.
- c. The participants who are registering for awards will have complimentary registration for **YAF2025** to be held on **Feb 7, 8 & 9** at Four Points by Sheraton Mahabalipuram Resort.
- d. Each registrants will be given a registration number per registration and only that number is to be mentioned in all the sheets.

Submission Materials

- a. A comprehensive portfolio detailing the project's concept, design process, plans, sections and images of the completed project (maximum of 4 nos of A2 - 10mm Thick Foam Boards).
- b. A project description (maximum 500 words) outlining the design philosophy and architectural innovation and any additional drawings or sketches supporting the submission (optional) can be included in the above mentioned foam boards itself.

Registration Details

- a. The participants are expected to register through the registration form and pay the respective entry fees applicable to obtain the registration number for each entry/category.
- b. The last date for registration is **5th Dec 2024**

Submission Deadline

All entries must be submitted not later than **25th Dec 2024**

Evaluation Process

A distinguished jury panel composed of eminent architects and office bearers of IIA TN chapter will review all entries.

The assessment will be based on:

- a. **Design Excellence:** Originality, creativity, and architectural innovation.
- b. **Functionality and Impact:** How well the project serves its intended purpose and its broader impact on the community.
- c. **Sustainability:** Environmental sensitivity, energy efficiency, and sustainable building practices.
- d. **Aesthetic and Cultural Context:** How the project reflects its surrounding environment and culture.

Display of Shortlisted Works

Shortlisted participants will have the opportunity to display their works at the **YAF 2025** venue. These works will be presented as part of an exhibition open to all festival attendees.

Awards Presentation

The awards will be presented during the **Valedictory Function of YAF 2025**. Winning entries will be recognized for their architectural excellence and will be presented with commemorative trophies and certificates.
